President of Council, Bill May opened the Public Hearing at 6:45 PM and explained that it was being held to allow public comment of the granting of a Special Use Permit for the Anthony Wayne Board of Education for property at 9565 Bucher Road, consisting of approximately 24 acres, in the Village of Whitehouse, Ohio that would allow for the construction of two soccer/lacrosse practice fields.

Donald Matt Dick of Anthony Wayne schools stated that the practice fields were needed and parking would be as far away as possible from the houses. Storm water issues are to be addressed. There will be no lighting and any additional changes would need to come back to Council.

- Will parking happen at the time of field installation? The fields will not be usable for one year
- Portable potties are unsightly – looking at a fence
- Local landowner for the fields – keep kids busy and out of trouble
- More traffic is unwanted, use of land at the school, flooding, sewage treatment park for fields, Don't like porta potties
- Opposed to proposal, parking, traffic, noise
- Developer of Steeplechase requests landscaping to shield the development
- Safety, noise from bike path already, too many soccer fields already
- Practice during the week, dump trucks from Steeplechase, a lot of traffic already
- Have the complex come in off of Dutch instead of Bucher

The next step is for Council to vote to send this matter to the Planning Commission. At 6:55, President of Council, Bill May closed the hearing.
