

LIST OF DESIRABLE STREET TREES

The following are a list of suggested street trees.

Small trees require a minimum 4'x4' growing space.

Medium trees require a minimum 6'x8' growing space.

Large trees require a minimum 8'x8' growing space and planted no less than 30' on center.
