Rules:

1. Must make and provide two (2) gallons of chili. It is important for all contestants to have the same amount to ensure equal time for tasting and voting.
2. No ingredient restrictions, but must have a list of ingredients displayed.
3. Must be cooked off-premises and brought to contest area while still hot.
4. Electricity will be provided, but you must bring your own 50' grounded extension cord. Sterno heat sources are also allowed.
5. Must be set up and ready to serve at 11:00 am and serve until chili is gone.
6. Village will provide 4 feet of table space, 2 chairs, napkins, bowls, and spoons.
7. You will need to bring paper towels, wet wipes, extension cord, and ladles.
8. At least one person must remain at the table at all times during serving time. Only 2 people allowed in serving area at a time.
9. Chili will be judged by the general public. Tickets will be sold for voting rights at \$1 each or 6 for \$5. The chili receiving the most votes will be declared the winner. In case of a tie, the proceeds will be split between winning contestants.
10. Winning chili will receive 50% of the ticket sales. The remaining 50% will be donated to the Veteran's Memorial Park fund.

Waiver of Liability.
