



DIVISION OF TAXATION

Dear Resident:

The Village of Whitehouse has a 1.5% Income Tax. This tax is imposed on all wages, salaries and other compensation paid by an employer or employers before any deduction and/or the net profits from the operation of a business, profession or other enterprise or activity. If you work in and pay tax to another municipality, Whitehouse allows a credit up to $\frac{3}{4}$ % of the taxed income, to be taken on your Village tax return. Although a partial credit is allowed, Whitehouse does not receive any money from the other municipalities.

Village of Whitehouse residents are required to file an annual Village income tax return by April 15th. Late filing fees of \$25.00 per month but not exceeding \$150.00 are assessed for tax returns filed after this date unless the resident was under a Federal Extension. Extensions must be filed with the tax return.

Quarterly estimated tax payments are due to the Village of Whitehouse. These payments are due April 15th, June 15th, September 15th and December 15th.

Please fill out and return the enclosed registration form within the next ten days. If you are required to file a Whitehouse income tax return, a tax reminder will be sent to you in January. If a tax form or quarterly estimated tax form are needed they can be picked up at the Municipal Office or downloaded from our website, www.whitehouseoh.gov.

The Village of Whitehouse levies an Income Tax of one and one-half percent (1½%) on all salaries, wages, commissions and other compensation, and on the net profits from business activities of its residents. Credit for other city tax paid is limited to ¾%. (Ordinance 237). All residents are required to file a tax return if they have any earnings and are a resident of the Village of Whitehouse for any part of the year.
