



Village of Whitehouse, Ohio College Scholarship

The Village of Whitehouse Scholarship Fund was established to provide financial assistance to residents who wish to pursue post-secondary education. We commend you for furthering your education and encourage you to apply for additional financial assistance. Two scholarships will be offered in the amount of Five hundred dollars (\$500) each. If selected, the recipients will be notified by mail for additional information. In order to qualify for this scholarship, the applicant must follow all instructions and guidelines listed below. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a current resident of the Village of Whitehouse, Ohio
- Must be attending or accepted into an accredited educational institution beyond the high school level or enrolled in a skilled trades program prior to the award date.
- Scholarship is paid directly to the educational institution or skills trade program and must be used during the 2018/2019 academic year.

Submission Documents

1. Completed application
2. Official transcript with cumulative GPA and all grades
3. One letter of recommendation from a college/university advisor/instructor or high school teacher/advisor and one letter of recommendation from a Village of Whitehouse resident
4. Proof of current residency in the Village of Whitehouse, Ohio
