- Person needed during the day
- Coverage for call off or scheduled time off
- Ensuing FPA requirement of 3 people/engine
- Officer in town 24/7
- Training
- Salary position that is flexible
- \$100,000 allocated
- Pay scale classification B, decision based on the candidate qualifications
- Wouldn't be in favor of opening position to the public with the internal candidates available

Motion by Bob Keogh, seconded by Rebecca Conklin Kleiboemer to recommend to Council to approve the position and amend the pay scale. 6 ayes

Other items discussed:

- Pleasure to work with all of the fire professionals, they are held in high regard
- Community excitement on activities, potluck, progressive neighborhood parties, interest in Connecting with neighbors, community picnic – Village funds, 4-6 Large community events, Summer concert series, Meet Village staff – staff cooks
- Wish List: Roundabout lighting, Alley behind the Whitehouse Inn, Handicap access at the Small quarry, Lights along the multi-use trail
