There were 6 applications submitted to the Village. All the applicants are presently in secondary education or are college bound and all have outstanding GPA's.


The decision to award the scholarships was difficult as all the applicants have unique talents and future goals. The Committee chose to look at financial need in order to wisely award the Village's money.




