



# 2019 Leaf Pick Up Schedule



Residents are asked to place leaves near the curb so that they can be picked up. Please ensure that leaves are free of sticks and rubbish. **DO NOT PLACE LEAVES ON THE PAVEMENT!** On-street parking causes problems during the collection process. Please avoid parking on the street when your district is scheduled. Village crews make every effort to keep to the posted schedule to ensure all residents are served. **If for any reason crews do not complete a scheduled route, rest assured that all leaves will be collected before the season ends.**
