RE: Cost of living Adjustment for 2023 Wages

For your consideration at this Tuesday's Committee of the Whole meeting is the annual presentation of the Consumer Price Index's (i.e., inflation) impact on wages. As this format is familiar to you all by now, I have included a document that summarizes historical annual inflation and the corresponding wage adjustment by Council. As you can see, everything significantly matched until 2020. In that year, Council awarded a Hazard Pay which translated to an effective pay award of 2.25-3.25% for Village employees, on average. In 2021, wages were increased 5.7%, matching the CPI for that time. This year, inflation was 8.2% through September.

Given the current revenue challenges and known additional operating expenses, the department heads have recommended a 3.0% Cost of Living Adjustment (C.O.L.A.). This recommendation is based on the tightrope balance of managing expenses and staying competitive amid workforce challenges. This topic along with any others you wish to discuss can be addressed this next Tuesday.
