Reconstruction of the Whitehouse Tree Commission meeting of May 23, 2024

The minutes of the April 25, 2024 meeting were approved

Possible items for a 2024 Growth Award application were discussed, including new member (Laurie Mauro, 2 pts), Diane DeYonker and Brian Petrell completing Tree Commission Academy (3 pts), more tree planted than removed (3 pts), and mulching interpretive program at Ohio Compost (2 pts).

Sheri Luedtke briefly reviewed the April Tree City USA meeting.

James Forrest mentioned that 2 hazardous trees had been removed

There will be a seminar on mulch/organic waste recycling at Ohio Compost Saturday July 13 at 1:00 p.m. The public is invited.

We discussed possibly partnering with the Metroparks on removal of the invasive (non-native) Tree of Heaven (*Ailanthus*) grove along the quarry behind the Village Hall. Steve Connelly will discuss it with a contact at the Metroparks.

James Forrest will look into our joining America In Bloom. There is an application form.

The Whitehouse Tree Inventory needs to be updated; we will try to do a portion of the Village again later this year.

Former Public Services rep Brian Petrell attended, and asked the Tree Commission to suggest appropriate trees for the grass center strip in the Preserve development. Oaks were recommended.
